

The high light of the day was the planting of 500 3 inch Hi-Bred Bluegills by Bob Stegmier. They are very colorfull, there a cross between a Sunfish and a Bluegill, they will grow fast and get extra large.

Two weeks later 500 Walleyes was released and in August 500 Small-mouth bass were also released and 2 milk cans of Fathead minnows that will reperduce were released in June.

In all, the planting of fish cost the Association \$940.00. The fish were purchased at the Stoney Creek Fish Farm in Grant, Michigan.

If any small fish are caught it would be nice if everyone would return the fish to the lake, to give the fish a chance to grow.
